RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MAY 13, 2009. A post entry fee of \$10.00 per horse will be charged after that date. Entry, drug and stall fees must be paid in full at the time of entry and accompany entry blanks. Pre-entered horses may be transferred from one division to another prior to June 13, 2009. **Post entries must be made one session prior to the class being entered - NO EXCEPTIONS.** Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together or share a tack stall must send entries in together.

HORSES SHOWN OUT OF TRAILERS will be charged \$30.00 per horse.

STALLS are \$100.00 each. TACK STALLS are \$125.00 each. INITIAL BEDDING NOT INCLUDED. Stalls have bottom doors only so you may want to bring stall guards. Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to stalls or fairgrounds property.

A \$25 fee will be charged to exhibitors who fail to check out with the show office before leaving the show.

ENTRY and STALL FEES will be refunded upon request before the closing date for entries. After May 13th, **ENTRY FEES** will be refunded due to bona fide injury or sickness of horse (or riders in equitation classes); veterinarian's certificate must be presented to the show secretary on the first day of the show or doctor's certificate in the case of riders. **STALL FEES** will not be refunded after the closing date for entries.

CAMPER PARKING FEE of \$85.00 water and electric hookups (dumping station available on grounds) is required for each camper or any type vehicle or tent using electricity or occupying a camper space. Camper parking spaces will be assigned. Fees must accompany entry. Please indicate number and size of campers on your reservation slip.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Horses must have a Negative Coggins Test Certificate and Eastern and Western Encephalitis Vaccination Certificate dated within six months of the show date.

ALL DOGS must have a current Rabies Certificate and must be kept on a leash at all times.

ACCESS to the Deerfield Fairgrounds will begin on Thursday June 18, 2009. Exhibitors wishing to arrive before this time may make **PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS** with Ron Boucher 603-463-7924. The fairgrounds charges \$20.00 per stall per day for early arrivals. This also applies to parking campers before Thursday, June 18. Any camper connecting to water and electricity prior to this date will be assessed a fee of \$15.00 per day. Stalls must be vacated by noon on Monday, June 22.

AMATEUR CLASSES & LADIES CLASSES are restricted to riders 18 and over. Ladies classes will qualify for Amateur Championships if shown by an amateur.

Management reserves the right to refuse a post entry in classes where an additional entry would make it necessary to split the class. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class where it is deemed advisable and to reschedule any divided class. Entries must be made before the close of the previous session. A class may be cancelled at the beginning of the session due to insufficient entries at the time. Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fees before or during a show without being liable for compensation.

HAY, GRAIN, AND SHAVINGS will be available on the grounds. Please try to pre-order on your entry blank. ICE will also be available on the grounds.

NO SMOKING IN THE BARN. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

Show arena footing is stonedust and sand. Dressage and carriage driving arenas are grass.

CROSS ENTERING IS ALLOWED BETWEEN CLASSIC PLEASURE DIVISIONS AND OTHER ENGLISH PLEASURE AND PLEASURE DRIVING DIVISIONS provided the toe and shoeing requirements are met. **ALL HEADERS (INCLUDING CLASSIC PLEASURE) MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 16 YEARS OF AGE as of December 1, 2008.**

Levels will be ridden in a large arena (20mX60m). Riders in this division may cross enter into other divisions. Riders doing so may request morning or afternoon test times in order to accommodate entering classes in the main ring. **HOWEVER, CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP IN THE MAIN RING DUE TO CONFLICTS** and vice versa. If you have a conflict, please notify the dressage coordinator. Once times have been scheduled, you will not be able to change your time unless there are scratches or another rider in the class is willing to switch times. Times will be mailed to you. If you have any questions, please call Shirley Haas at 603-654-9360.

The USDF numbers clearly marked on the entry forms will facilitate the reporting of scores to the USDF. Junior rider tests are open to riders who have not reached their 17th birthday as of December 1, 2008.

Results will be posted and pinning will take place only when all competitors in that class have competed. Scored tests will be available to read, but will not be handed out until the class has been completed.

Championship ribbons and coolers will be awarded for the following:

Introductory Level. Based on the average of the two scores in that level.

Junior Rider Training Level. Based on the average of two scores in that level, one of which must be from Test 4.

Senior Rider Training Level. Based on the average of two scores in that level, one of which must be from Test 4.

Junior Rider First Level. Based on the average of two scores in that level, one of which must be from Test 4.

Senior Rider First Level. Based on the average of two scores in that level, one of which must be from Test 4.

Second Level. Based on the average of two scores in that level.

\$100 in prize money will be awarded to the high point champions (\$65) and the reserve champions (\$35) for all levels except the Introductory Level. These awards will be presented before the Dressage Pleasure class (starting at 6:00pm on Saturday evening)
