

# Granite State Morgan Horse Society Inc

## Year End Awards

Mission statement for year end awards: To encourage Granite State members to show their owned or leased registered Morgan Horses in competition in the New England area. All horses must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association registry.

### Rules:

1. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR KNOWING THE RULES AND FOR NOTIFYING THE POINT SECRETARY OF ANY DISCREPANCY RESTS WITH THE EXHIBITOR.
2. Both the owner/leasee of the horse and the exhibitor must be members of Granite State Morgan Horse Society Inc.
3. Members must be in good standing with the Granite State Morgan Horse Society Inc. and have a Granite State nomination form and a copy of registration papers or lease agreements for each horse and exhibitor filed with the GS point secretary for points to be accumulated. If a horse is purchased during the show season please submit form and copies of papers within 2 weeks of purchase.
4. Granite State Morgan Horse Society Inc points secretary will record points without member submission from the following shows: USEF rated Morgan shows; Vermont Morgan, Connecticut Morgan, Granite State Morgan, Maine Morgan, New England Morgan, Massachusetts Morgan, and NHH & TA rated shows; New Hampshire Horse & Trail, NH Arabian, Twin State Saddlebred, New England Pony Owners, Cheshire Fair, Hopkinton Fair, Lancaster Fair, Deerfield Fair and all five North Shore Horseman's Association shows. Points for any other show in New England must be submitted by exhibitor/horse owner. Submitted points are due to the points secretary within 30 days of the last day of the show being submitted. No points accepted later than November 1<sup>st</sup>. No phone submissions please.
5. "Open division" will only accumulate points from classes open to all breeds.
6. Points values : : 1<sup>st</sup> – 10, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6, 4<sup>th</sup> – 4, 5<sup>th</sup> – 2, 6<sup>th</sup> - 1. All championship placings will be rated as double. Points will be weighted as follows: Granite State classes - X2.5. All Morgan USEF rated A shows - X2. NHH&T/NEHC rated shows - X1. Any non rated shows (fun shows) will be counted toward the Fun Show award.

7. A reporting form is attached. Photocopies are accepted. Forms are also available on [www.nhmorgans.com](http://www.nhmorgans.com) Additional forms are also available from the point secretary upon written request with a self addresses stamped envelope.
  8. Year end awards will be given to the horse accumulating the most points in a performance division with the exceptions of Equitation where only the rider will accumulate points. Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division. Junior Exhibitor will be awarded to sixth.
  9. When a transfer of ownership occurs during the show season, the point scoring secretary must be notified at once if points accumulated prior to the transfer are to be added to points accumulated after the transfer.
- A. OPEN – This division will only accumulate points from classes open to all breeds. (8 Awards)

- C. PARK - This division will accumulate points from Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows. (2 Awards)

- H. PLEASURE DRIVING - - This division will accumulate points from Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows. (3 Awards)

- I. CLASSIC PLEASURE DRIVING - This division will accumulate points from Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows. (2 Awards)

    - a) Morgan Classic Pleasure Driving; Stallions, Mares or Geldings b) Masters Morgan Classic Pleasure Driving
  2. Ladies Morgan Classic Pleasure Driving

- J. JUNIOR HORSE - This division will accumulate points from Junior Horse Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows (2 Awards)
1. Junior Horse Saddle
    - a) All junior horse saddle classes b) all Morgan Junior horse saddle classes

2. Junior Horse Driving
    - a) All junior horse driving classes b) all Morgan Junior horse driving classes
- K. EQUITATION - This division will accumulate points from Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows. NO medal classes will be counted toward these awards. (17 Awards)
1. Leadline

  2. Walk/trot or jog – 11 & under
    - a) Saddleseat b) Hunter seat c) Stock seat d) Classic
  3. Junior Equitation- 13 & under

- L. Junior Exhibitor - This division will accumulate points from Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows. The exhibitor is responsible for ensuring that the points secretary have the correct information about their age division and discipline to accurately point the NHH&TA and NEHC classes. ( 12 Awards)
1. Beginner Pleasure Saddleseat 11 & under
  2. Beginner Pleasure Hunter Seat 11 & under
  3. Beginner Pleasure Stock seat 11 & Under
  4. Beginner Pleasure Classic 11 & Under

M. MISCELLANEOUS - This division will accumulate points from Morgan classes at NHH&TA and NEHC rated shows as well as USEF rated Morgan shows. (13 Awards)

2. Road Hack: Classes that accumulate points toward this award are as follows:

- 12. Gentlemen's Pleasure: Classes that accumulate points toward this award are as follows:
  - a) All Gentleman's Pleasure riding and driving classes b) all Morgan Gentleman's Pleasure Riding and Driving classes
- 13. Hunter Jumper Over Fences: Classes that accumulate points toward this award are as follows:
  - a) All Hunter/jumper classes b) All Morgan hunter/jumper classes

#### N. Trail Riding (5 Awards)

- 1. NH Pleasure Trail Riding Senior (Adult) & Junior (18 & under)
  - a) To qualify one must have completed in one or more trail rides affiliated with NHH&TA.
  - b) One point will be given for each mile completed on each ride. Regular loop and alternated loop will both be recognized.
- 2. Pleasure Trail Riding – Outside of NH
  - a) To qualify one must have completed one or more trail rides outside NH. These rides must be affiliated with NEH&TA.
  - b) One point will be given for each mile completed on each ride.
- 3. Pleasure Trail Driving
  - a) To qualify one must have completed on or more trail drives held within New England.
  - b) Drives must be affiliated with NHH&TA, NEH&TA or NERCA.
- 4. Competitive Trail Riding
  - a) To qualify one must have completed two or more ECTRA sanctioned rides.
  - b) Points to be accumulated following the NHH&TA competitive trail ride system.
  - c) Ten bonus points to be earned on each ride for special award recognitions, ie. Best Morgan, Rookie Award, Novice Award, Best Senior etc.

#### O. DRESSAGE (8 Awards)

1. 4 awards in Senior division – Intro Level, Training Level, First Level, Second & Above (may be divided if three or more entered in this level or above.)
2. 4 awards in Junior division– Intro Level, Training Level, First Level, Second & Above (may be divided if three or more entered in this level or above.)
  - a) At least two test scores must be submitted for the calendar year.
  - b) Each test score must be from a different judge and Dressage show.
  - c) Only official United States Dressage Federation (USDF) officiated Dressage Shows will count toward year-end scores.
  - d) The minimum average score of the two or more tests must be 52%.
  - e) The same horse/rider team combinations may only submit test scores from no more than two consecutive divisions. Horse/rider teams that submit tests that are not consecutive will forfeit the lower of the two divisions.

P. CARRIAGE DRIVING (2 Awards)

1. One Adult award and One Junior exhibitor award
2. Events – Any driving event in New England qualifies for this award including carriage shows, marathons, sleigh rallies, combined driving events and HDTs (Horse Driving Trials) and ADTs (Arena Driving Trials),. These do not need to be affiliated but must be judged and placed.

Q. An entry is defined as a FUN SHOW AWARD This is a cumulative point award for fun shows in the New England region not NHH&TA, NEHC or USEF affiliated. Points need to be submitted and accompanied with a show class list. The class list MUST be signed by the show Secretary and he/she must state what ribbon was won on the list (2 Awards)

2. Junior Exhibitor
